Effective May 18, 2010, a Letter of Understanding (attached) between the DGC BC, AMPTP and the CFTPA is in effect that confirms the work of background coordination to be within the jurisdiction of the DGC BC.

This work is to be performed only by DGC BC Members in Good Standing working under a DGC BC Deal Memo as an “Additional Assistant Director (Background Coordinator)”. The onus rests with the production to confirm the Membership status of any individuals prior to them being hired to perform this work. The attached Letter of Understanding outlines the terms under which an Additional Assistant Director (Background Coordinator) may be engaged, including rates of pay and minimum call. Except as modified in the Letter of Understanding, all other terms and conditions of the 2009 – 2012 DGC BC Collective Agreement shall apply to Additional Assistant Directors (Background Coordinators).

Any Member in Good Standing is eligible to work in this capacity, however only Members who have Additional Assistant Director (Background Coordinator) as their recognized DGC category, or other Full Member Assistant Directors may list themselves as Background Coordinators on the Member Availability List.
