The **UBC Certificate in Entertainment Administration** was developed and launched in Fall 2003 in response to an industry need for highly trained professionals who have an interest and desire to work in entertainment business management and the film and television industry.

Two Program formats available:

The **Full-time certificate** program (300 hours, 20 hrs/week instruction minimum, evenings and weekends) is delivered over a 13-14 week period, which includes a two-week internship or project assignment and workshops designed to assist you in branding yourself for entertainment industry employment. Tuition: \$8,500 **eligible for student loan/HRSDC funding*

The **NEW Part-time certificate** designed specifically for professionals who want to continue working while earning their certificate. This format allows you to take courses at your own pace and upon successful completion receive a UBC certificate. Students must complete the core courses (approx. 240 hours) (**does not include Internship and Job Readiness Workshop*) and complete program requirements within 2 years. Tuition paid course by course: *approx. \$7,500*
