*Directors Guild of Canada, BC, Announces amendment  
to the Permittee Logbook Holder Program*

Vancouver, B.C. – August 3, 2010 – The Directors Guild of Canada, British Columbia District Council (DGC BC) Executive Board has amended the Permittee Logbook Holder Program to remove the Genre Requirement for Associate Membership eligibility.

Previously, Permittee Logbook Holders needed to achieve a minimum of 45 days on Long Form Productions (Feature Films, TV Movies, etc) and 45 days on Television Series, to qualify for Membership in the DGC. The Executive Board has decided that this requirement is no longer necessary.

The DGC BC has developed the Permittee Logbook Holder Program as a requirement for those interested in acquiring work experience as a PA with the goal of attaining Associate Membership in the Directors Guild of Canada.

Changes to the Permittee Program are a result of the DGC BC's aim to encourage Production Assistants to further their goals, continue their career objectives, and attain their Membership.
